

September 16, 2023 - Saturday Traveling to Milan, Italy

Our wonderful adventure begins as we take an overnight flight to Milan, Italy. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you start your dream vacation. We are happy to assist travelers from different airports than Omaha.

September 17, 2023 - Sunday Milan - Alba, Piedmonte We arrive at Milan Malpensa airport in the

early morning and are met by our favorite tour director, who will follow us during our journey in Italy. We are off on a half-day guided tour of Milan, one of Europe's wealthiest cities, known for stylish shops, galleries, and restaurants. Life in Milan is at a faster pace than in most Italian cities. We will visit the infamous Duomo, the landmark of Milan. The Gothic cathedral took nearly six centuries to complete and is dedicated to Saint Mary of the Nativity. Across Duomo Square, we will find the majestic Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, one of the world's most glamorous and oldest shopping malls, built in 1867. Our tour will take us past the impressive landmarks of Piazza Sempione with the Arch of Peace, the Castello Sforzesco, ranked among Europe's largest citadels, and La Scala, the opera house. Lunch at leisure before we continue towards Alba, in the Piedmonte region, known for its sophisticated cuisine and world-class wines, including Barolo. September 18, 2023 - Monday Truffle Hunt & Wine Tastings

We enjoy our brekfast. Next, we head out to experience one of our journey's biggest highlights; a two-hour truffle hunt. We meet our hunter and his dog, and off we go! Surrounded by the stunning

Langhe scenery, we are searching for the "black and white gold" while learning about the importance of truffles in their natural environment. A truffle tasting follows before we continue with a visit to a local winery. The Piedmonte region fosters some of the highest quality wines in Italy, and even the French neighbors have admitted they are jealous. We will taste some grand wines; the Barbera d'Alba, and the king-of-them-all - the Nebbiolo Barolo. Cold cuts are included; it doesn't get any better than this! September 19, 2023 - Tuesday Santa Margherita - Portofino - Rapallo

After a hearty breakfast, we travel towards the crescent-shaped Liguria region. Its Mediterranean coastline is known as the Italian Riviera. Stylish Portofino, Santa Margherita, and Rapallo appear as pearls on a string. We will meet our local Ligurian guide and tour Rapallo and Santa Margherita. Check-in to our hotel, where a delicious dinner will be served tonight. We recommend an evening stroll; the views are stunning. B | D

September 20, 2023 - Wednesday Portofino

This morning, we will depart for a short boat ride to Portofino, the picturesque seaside village with bright-colored houses lining the shore. Portofino is also known as the resort of the "rich and famous." Designer boutiques and dozens of cafes and restaurants line the main square, allowing visitors a chance to experience the real Italian "Bella Vita." You will have free time to enjoy and visit the church of San Giorgio, which is said to have relics of Saint George. You can also visit the Brown Castle, built in the 15th century and used for harbor defense over the centuries. Portofino is the

place to people-watch and enjoy a gelato, an espresso, and a light lunch before we return by boat for a leisurely evening in Rapallo. B

September 21, 2023 - Thursday Pisa - Tuscany

After a laidback breakfast, we are off to Pisa. We will experience (from outside) the infamous Leaning Tower, the free-standing bell tower of Pisa Cathedral, known for its nearly four-degree lean., the result of an unstable foundation. Next, we continue through the beautiful Tuscan region to our accommodation for the next three nights, a very special Tuscan villa. A welcome dinner is served, and you will soon feel the genuine Tuscan hospitality. The evening is for leisure to soak in the atmosphere of this very special place. B | D

September 22, 2023 - Friday Florence

After breakfast, we are off for a short drive to Florence. We begin our visit with a guided walking tour of the "Cradle of Renaissance" to admire the majestic Duomo built in 1296 along Giotto's Bell Tower and the Baptistery with its renowned "Gates of Paradise" doors. We will follow the medieval streets to the most striking squares in Florence; Piazza della Signoria, an open-air museum. Then, we head to the Academy Gallery for a visit and to take a closer look at the breathtaking statue of David by Michelangelo. Lunch is served at a local restaurant before you are off on your own to experience more of what Florence has to offer. You will enjoy the local leather works (handbags, gloves), fine Florentine paper, jewelry shops, and, of course, Ponte Vecchio, the infamous bridge. Return to our villa in the early evening. After breakfast, we travel back in time to the Middle Ages. Siena, a beautiful city with a historic center that has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We will take a walking tour of Siena and visit the famous Piazza del Campo, one of Europe's greatest medieval squares, and the site of Siena's famous horse race, the Palio di Siena. The sweet-smelling trattorias, the sounds of the artisans, and the spouting fountains along the mystery of the Diana River are just some of the reasons why Siena is such a gem to visit. Next, we will drive to San Gimignano for a walking tour. Fortified walls and a watchtower show power and prosperity in the Middle Ages, though only 13 of the town's original 76 towers still remain. We will enjoy an hour at leisure in San Gimignano before meeting with our friend, Pierluigi, at his local winery. You will enjoy a wine tasting and lunch, guaranteed to be the most entertaining ever. Return to our villa for the evening. B | T | L

September 24, 2023 - Sunday Assisi - Rome

After a hearty breakfast, we say a fond farewell to Tuscany and our Tuscan family. We are headed towards Rome, but we will make a stop on the way to the hillside town of Assisi, the birthplace of one of the most popular Catholic saints in history. Saint Francis of Assisi is the founder of the Franciscan order and is better known as the revered patron saint of animals. We will spend time at the stunning church and enjoy the breathtaking views of the surrounding hills and villages. We will proceed to the Eternal City, Rome, reached in the late afternoon. Check-in to our centrally located hotel. The evening is yours to relax; take a stroll in the neighborhood; you will soon understand why Rome wasn't built in a day! B



September 25, 2023 - Monday Rome

Today is your chance to experience Federico Fellini's classic "La Dolce Vita" (The Sweet Life) and take in the atmosphere of the famous movie "Eat, Pray, Love." See for yourself the top sites in Rome, including restaurants, fountains, piazzas (squares), and neighborhoods featured in books and movies. Retrace the footsteps of Elizabeth, played by Julia Roberts, who spends her time in Rome searching for beauty and exploring Italian food. Our guided tour includes the highlights of Eternal Rome with its Roman squares: from Piazza Navona to Trevi Fountain. Lunch is enjoyed at a unique restaurant ...for movie lovers only! After lunch, we are ready to step back in time and visit "Ancient Rome," including the Roman Forum and the Coliseum. Its real name was Flavian Amphitheater, after the emperors who built it in the first century AD. Coliseum refers to the "colossal" statue of Nero that stood at the entrance at one time. The evening is yours to explore more of Rome; it will not disappoint. B | L

September 26, 2023 - Tuesday The Vatican City*

We are up early! A ten-minute bus ride takes us to another country, Vatican City. Before starting our visit, we will enjoy breakfast in the magnificent setting of the Vatican Museums. Together with our expert local guide, we will tour the Vatican Museums - a massive collection of ancient Greek sculptures, medieval tapestries, and Renaissance paintings. Our visit culminates in the Sistine Chapel, the room where the Pope is elected. Next, we will visit Saint Peter's Basilica, by far the largest church in Christendom. We will see Michelangelo's Pieta, sculpted when he was just 24 years old, as well as Bernini's seven-story bronze canopy located above the main altar.




