

March 19, 2024 - Tuesday Traveling to Cuba

March 21, 2024 - Thursday Viñales - Tobacco Farm - Cigar Rolling

Located three hours from Havana, Viñales is a beautiful quaint Cuban town nestled among soaring limestone cliffs and tobacco



farms. These limestone mogotes, combined with Viñales' vibrantly colored casas in shades of orange, green, pink, yellow, blue, and red, have earned the Vally of Viñales a World Heritage designation. We will explore tobacco country like a Cuban farmer! Stop at a working tobacco farm run by a lovely multi-generational family. Learn the special technique and secret family recipe for rolling cigars with a twist. We will continue into the lush Viñales Valley to our special viewing point, one of the most tranguil places on the planet. Lunch today includes a panoramic view of the Vinales countryside. We return to Havana for an evening at leisure. We suggest you join us for an informal and light dinner, cocktails, and ...a cigar? B | L


March 22, 2024 - Friday Hemingway - Arts Workshop - Mojito

After enjoying our breakfast, we enter the world of Ernest Hemingway with a visit to the Hemingway House, Finca La Vigia (meaning 'lookout house'). Famed novelist Earnest Hemingway lived at this sprawling mansion with his wife, Martha, from 1940-1960. View the perfectly preserved home where many of the Hemingway personal furniture and belongings remain intact since the day that "Papa," the U.S.ambassador-in-spirit left. View his famous boat on display, the Pilar in which he used to patrol for Nazis in the Caribbean waters and featured in his novel "Islands in the Stream". We will take a break for a delicious lunch and refreshing drink in a paladar. A paladar is a restaurant that is individually owned by Cuban people. Next, an exhilarating workshop with a local art organization. Dive deeper into cuba's art culture as you visit a local community arts organization. Get to know inspiring individuals and create your own small craft project with them. And we are not done yet! Our Mojito-making class will wrap up our wonderful day in the most fun way. March 23, 2024 - Saturday Cienfuegos - Trinidad

After enjoying breakfast, we will depart for Cienfuegos. Explore the historic French town of Cienfuegos, considered one of Cuba's most beautiful colonial cities. It has been recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2005, and the colonial-era buildings will take your breath away. Cienfuegos is also one of the chief seaports of Cuba, a center of the sugar trade as well as coffee and tobacco. While sugarcane is the chief crop, local farmers also grow coffee. We will spend a few hours seeing this beautiful town and savor a delightful local lunch. We continue to Trinidad, one of Cuba's oldest cities, which remains lined with cobblestone streets

TRAVEL LICENSE LEGAL COMPLIANCE NOTE

Our supplier, CUBA CANDELA ("the Company"), a U.S. entity incorporated in the State of Delaware, is subject to U.S. jurisdiction authorized to provide travel services in connection with travel-related transactions involving Cuba, pursuant to the Cuban Assets Control Regulations, 31 CFR 5 Part 515.

The Company holds a general license authorization to provide travel services pursuant to §515.572(a) (1)("General licenses – Authorization to provide travel services").

The Company maintains a policy to comply with required reports and recordkeeping pursuant to §515.572(b)(1) and §515.572(b)(2) ("Required reports and recordkeeping"), including retaining for at least five years from the date of the transaction a certification from each customer indicating the section of 31 CFR 5 Part 515 that authorizes each customer to travel to Cuba. In the case of a customer traveling under a specilc license, the specific license number or a copy of the license is maintained on file. Additionally, the Company retains the names and addresses of individual travelers with all other information required by §501.601 - such records which must be furnished to the Office of Foreign Assets Control on demand pursuant to §501.602.

On behalf of its customers, the Company makes travel-related transactions authorized by general license pursuant to §515.560(a) ("Travelrelated transactions to, from, and within Cuba by persons subject to U.S. jurisdiction"), including all transportation-related transactions ordinarily incident to travel to, from, and within Cuba, including the acquisition of Cuban visas authorized pursuant to §515.560(c)(1) and all transactions ordinarily incident to travel within Cuba, including payment of living expenses and the acquisition in Cuba of goods for personal consumption there authorized pursuant to §515.560(c)(2).

The Company's customers engage in a full-time schedule of authorized activities while in Cuba, pursuant to the following general license category: §515.574(a) ("Support for the Cuban People – General license").

With respect to travel authorized by §515.574(a), the Company's customers comply with all applicable requirements including those stated in §515.574(a).

The Company maintains a strict policy to not conduct, facilitate, engage in, or permit its Customers to engage in, tourism to Cuba. For the avoidance of doubt, the Company does not engage in tourism to Cuba. The Company maintains a strict policy to prohibit tourist travel to Cuba. For the avoidance of doubt, the Company does not engage in tourism to Cuba.
